The accounts have been prepared in accordance with conventional historic cost principles and have not been adjusted to take account of either changes in general purchasing power or specific prices.

Depreciation has been calculated on the reducing balance basis to write off the cost of fixed assets, other than freehold land and buildings, over their expected economic lives at the following annual rates :
